WATER COMMISSIONER'S REPORT
FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2009

As proposed at last year's AGM, the east and west divisions of the water system have been joined. The system works very well. Only one question remains, the lines were installed in a different manner than were originally intended. While the system works well, it could be smoother if adjusted to the originally planned system. We asked for approval of up to 150,000 pesos and used only a little more than 85,000 pesos so if approved the funds are still available for the change.

On another point, as stated last year a problem had arisen with our account with CFE. After a great deal of effort the problem has been solved as of January 2010, with the help of Pedro Moldanado, who is in charge of all the potable water in Poncitlan. Now both our main western and our eastern well are on the municipal rate.

We point this out as we had a small operations loss last year (379 pesos) leaving nothing to be allocated to possible improvements which are not capital in nature. This should be solved with the change in the current year. I advise no change in the rate per cubic meter for the 2010 year.

As a matter of ongoing capital improvements, we are asking for 150 pesos in dues for the year. This is planned for further automation of the system.

As I retire from this position, I am sure that the incoming board and Doug Reno in particular will continue to serve the members to the best of their abilities.
